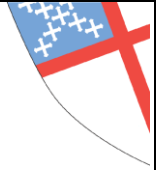

Dear People of God,

Happy Father's Day! You may have called him "dad", "father", "pop" or, if your parents were divorced, you may have called him by his first name, but there was probably someone who filled that role in your life. He may have been a workaholic, an alcoholic, or an absent father- but there was someone who tried to fill that void in your life, and today we remember them.

My own dad worked hard to provide for our family. His work often kept him on the road and there were many times that his chair sat empty at the dinner table. My love of tools and fixing things is a direct result of times that we spent in my early years. Later when I was in sports he was often in the stands rooting me on! After I left home, and later married our relationship was somewhat distant. In his retirement, I would visit him usually once a year and we would talk occasionally on the telephone. I did see him shortly before his death. My sisters and I scattered his ashes at a National park north of Phoenix, AZ.

As I reflect on Father's Day, I am reminded of the lifelong ministry that fatherhood is intended to be. As iron sharpens iron, fathers are intended to mold, shape, and encourage their children - with love, grace and discipline. They are also called by God to love, honor and cherish the mother of their children with commitment, devotion, and sacrifice. I can only pray that my own children have seen those traits in me.

If you had a great dad, try to follow in his footsteps. If your dad was not the kind of dad that you would have liked, use this Father's Day to truly forgive him. And if your ministry of fatherhood is still in progress- pray for the strength, grace, wisdom and guidance to not only to bless your children (and love their mom) but to fulfill your God-given role!

**Summary of Vestry Meeting last Monday June 15, 2015**

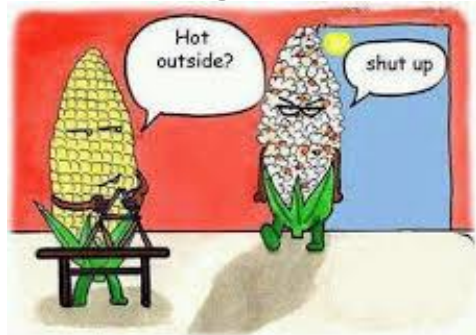
A quorum of 7 was present. Minutes, Financial Reports were approved,

- handout of all building costs to date was handed out. We have requested our second \$200,000 from the trustees to pay construction bills.
- A new banner is in the works for St David's. It is being made by a parishioner.
- New roof on the church will be galvalume metal and silver in color- I t will be on the church, parish hall and new construction. At this time we are not contemplating doing the rest of the roof.
- We discussed the possibility of having a well installed, but due to concerns about salts (chlorides) in the well water, we decided to postpone the decision until our gray water supply is compromised.
- Update given on Memorial garden progress to date- new memorial garden forms/guidelines distributed.
- Utility easement recorded for FPL line going under the driveway
- Deacon Carla Rhodes in place and happy to be at St. David's- we are happy to have her here too!
- Jean LaPointe has begun reviewing stewardship plans for the fall- more to come
- Point of clarification is that the Design and Decorating committee (advisory only) are doing the behind the scenes work, but the vestry will actually be the decision making body of all finished in the church and grounds.
- Jeanne Weaver gave update on St. Barnabas ministry
- Signed contract with ATP for fire safety requirements, still reviewing bids on security quotes
- KAY KELSEY Scholarship determination, letters to be going out soon.
- STH noted that he would be mostly unavailable next week due to family coming to town.

**Please be careful as you are walking around the construction site!**

Last week all of the shingles and roofing were torn off the parish hall and the church to make ready for our new roof. As a result there were many nails that didn't quite make it to the dumpster. The contactor has run a magnet over the area, but there are occasional nails- if you see one, please pick it up! Last week we had two workmen step on nails and two vehicles get tires punctured. Please do not drive in the areas west or south of the Church. Many thanks! STH+

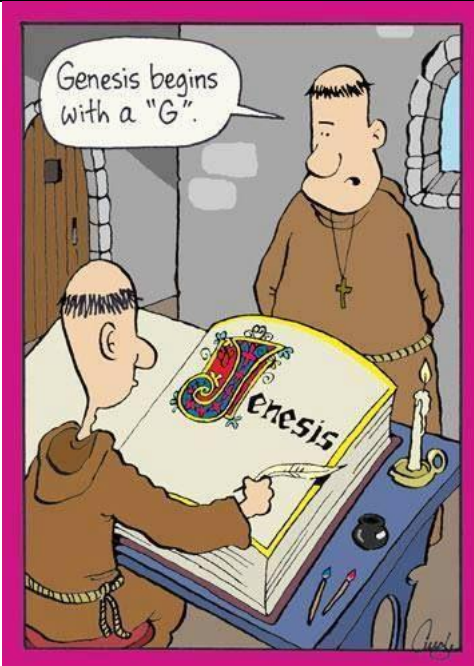
